The three winners will be chosen by a panel of Father Christmas's helpers the following day and will be notified by telephone as soon as possible.


The Make a Christmas Wish competition isn't the only bit of festive fun on offer.

MAJOR FLOODING EXERCISE SET FOR WATERSIDE

Stratford will be the site of a major Environment Agency exercise deploying new temporary flood barriers.

The exercise, set for 7am on November 7th, will take place on Waterside. Businesses will still be accessible but Waterside will be closed to traffic for most of the day.

The Environment Agency has bought 40km of temporary flood barrier which can be deployed at suitable sites - one of which has been identified as Stratford - during a flood.

As part of the exercise on November 7th, the Agency's field team will test their barrier deployment plan and procedures, train staff and test working arrangements with partners so they can quickly and safely erect the barriers during a flood with minimum disruption.

As well as a road closure to allow Warwickshire County Council to carry out drainage investigation and maintenance works, pedestrians will also be restricted from walking along the areas immediately in front and behind the barrier, which span between the Encore Pub and the junction of Waterside and Chapel Lane. Businesses on Waterside will still be accessible.

The EA will have staff available during the exercise to provide information about access restrictions, alternative routes and general flood advice.
